Makah Tribal Council Approves Moving into Phase 2

Makah Tribal Council enacted Resolution 141-20 approving Health Order 09-20. We are moving into Phase 2 of the Makah COVID-19 Public Health Protocols effective Tuesday, December 15, 2020.

There are no new cases of COVID-19 on the Makah Reservation since November 23, 2020, and there is no known community transmission.

Protocols for Phase 2:

- Small Gatherings of 10 or less are allowed outdoors while avoiding close contact outside of the household group.
- All indoor gatherings are prohibited.

Household Groups

Household Groups "Pods" are now reinstated. Household Units not located on the Reservation may not be considered a part of a Household Group for this order's duration.
